The Minister of Transport and Roads of Queensland Mark Bailey said that people should expect much more work "but it would be a case of "short-term pain for long-term gains"". Great projects needed The mayor of the Moreton Bay Regional Council, Peter Flannery, said the authorities had known about the "pretty bad" congestion on the Bruce Highway for years. "We have to go in front of the game now, in front of the ball and start looking at significant projects that are actually going to make a big difference in the generations to come," he said. "As we welcome these ads and projects, we want to look at the bigger picture and the biggest and most significant projects like the West Moreton Connector Road we need down the western side of our region and even the Moreton Connector on the east side. "We believe that those two projects will press the Bruce highway, but they need the effort, they need the holes to go ahead with them. " Governments started early planning for the \$2.1 billion project "Moreton Connector" - which will involve extensive work on the Bruce Highway, Gateway Motorway and Gympie Arterial Road, and the construction of a new arterial corridor between Dohles Rocks Road and Anzac Avenue. Like the current Bruce Highway updates, the project is based on Commonwealth funding for 80% and Queensland's government commits the remaining 20 percent.
