How to hook up directv receiver to tv

By Steven Hill i Jupiterimages/Photos.com/Getty Images Of the TV services available in your area, you've narrowed your choices to two offerings from Verizon. Both its FiOS TV and DirecTV services sound good to you. In choosing the right plan for you, you'll need to see what each individual package in each service offers, what the prices are and decide what matches what you both want and can afford. The FiOS TV service offered by Verizon comes in three different packages. At \$65 per month, the Prime HD Plan is the cheapest of them as of 2011. It offers you over 195 channels. The Extreme HD Plan costs \$75 and provides more than 285 channels. For \$90, subscribers can choose the Ultimate HD Plan. This final plan offers more than 350 channels. All three FiOS packages comes with free premium installation. If ordered online, the activation fee is waived. Verizon also offers its DirecTV service. DirecTV comes in one of four packages. The first is Choice Xtra. This package provides over 210 channels for \$38 per month. Choice Xtra + DVR is the second package, offering the same channels as the first but with an included digital video recorder. It costs \$45. Choice Ultimate + HD + DVR offers more than 225 channels, including 50 HD channels and a DVR for \$65. Premier is the final available package. This offers all of the channels from the Ultimate package in addition to all available premium movie channel for \$86. In terms of channels available and price, FiOS and DirecTV differ. For example, the cheapest FiOS package offers 195 channels while the cheapest DirecTV package offers 210. The DirecTV plan is also \$27 cheaper. However, the FiOS package offers more HD content, as well as bonuses like free installation. All FiOS plans comes with a DVR unit, where a DVR is offered with three out of four DirecTV plans. DirecTV may also be unavailable to you if, for instance, your home doesn't have a clear view of the southern sky. Choosing the TV service that's right for you depends on different factors. If you want the most available HD content, consider FiOS. If money is an issue, then DirecTV offers several packages cheaper than FiOS's cheapest available plan. If you live in an apartment building or house without a good view of the southern sky, then your choice might be physically limited to FiOS. Make the choice based on your budget, the channel package that sounds good to you, and your home's physical setting. By Diane Dilov-Schultheis i Thomas Northcut/Photodisc/Getty Images Cable companies across the country provide both home and business customers with an alternative to satellite television broadcasts. You can select from a number of programming packages that include local channels, special sports channels, international channels and a number of music and movie channels. In order for a television to display the selected programming, you must connect a cable box to the TV. This is possible with two coaxial cables, or one coaxial and an RCA audio/video cable that has three connectors on it. Turn off and unplug the TV and cable box. Place them both near a cable outlet and each other. i Hemera Technologies/AbleStock.com/Getty Images Hook up one end of a coaxial cable to the cable wall outlet and the other end of this cable to the back of the cable box using the "In" jack. Connect the second coaxial cable to the back of the cable box using the "Out to TV" jack. Connect the other end of this cable to the back of the television using the "In" jack. Plug both the television and cable box into a power source and turn them on to view cable programming. Turn off and unplug the TV and cable box. Place them both near a cable outlet and each other. Check to see if you have available A/V jacks on both the TV and cable box. These are the red and white audio jacks and yellow video jack. Hook up one end of a coaxial cable to the cable wall outlet and the other end of this cable to the back of the cable box using the "In" jack. i Photodisc/Photodisc/Getty Images Connect one end of the RCA audio/video cable to the back of the cable box using the "Audio/Video Out" jacks. Put the connectors into the jacks of the same color, such as the yellow connector in the yellow jack. Connect the other end of the RCA A/V cable into the back of the television using the "Audio/Video In" jacks in the same manner--matching the cable connector colors to the jacks. Plug both the television and cable box into a power source and turn them on to view cable programming. DirecTV provides millions of customers with satellite television every day. A basic satellite setup includes one DirecTV receiver connected to one television set but you may want to watch TV in another room also. This kind of a setup requires you to hook up a second DirecTV receiver in this location, since each television needs its own satellite receiver to broadcast satellite programming. This does require basic satellite installation knowledge to complete properly. Check to see if there is a second coaxial cable coming from the satellite dish to the ground block (it should be within three to five feet of your satellite dish). Add a cable to the dish, if needed, as described in Step 2. Carefully remove the LNB that extends out from the dish with a screwdriver without moving the satellite dish. The slightest alteration in the dish alignment can affect the satellite signal. Attach a coaxial cable to the second jack on the LNB. Replace the LNB on the dish. Run this cable to the ground block. Cut the cable at this location with wire cutters. Add a connector to the cable. Attach this cable to the ground block. If there is a single ground block, replace it with a dual one. Attach a connector to additional cable and connect it to the other side of the ground block. Run this cable from this location to the site of the second DirecTV receiver. Use a drill with the proper bit to go through any walls or flooring, if necessary. Seal these holes using plugs or sealant. Insert a wall plate for the satellite cable in a nearby wall if you want, or simply run the cable directly to the receiver. This varies depending on your building type and specific wants. Cut the coaxial cable and attach a connector to it. Connect this cable to the second DirecTV receiver. By James T Wood i Mike Coppola/Getty Images Entertainment/Getty Images DirecTV receivers have one or more USB ports on them, but most USB accessories won't work with them. This might make them seem vestigial, but the USB ports on DirecTV receivers do have a few uses, like connecting an over the air antenna module or providing power to USB devices. You can purchase an AM21 Antenna Module that will allow your DirecTV receiver to also get over-the-air channels. It plugs in to the USB port on the DirecTV receiver, but that is the only DirecTV device that will work with the USB port on the receiver. As of December 2013, the AM21 is not available on DirecTV's website, but third-party sellers still have them available for purchase (see link in Resources). If, for whatever reason, your DirecTV receiver is unable to download updates to its software via the satellite connection, the USB port can be used by DirecTV technicians to load software updates to the receiver. Users aren't able to access this functionality and shouldn't try, since it will void the warranty and could result in the receiver being kicked off of the DirecTV network. The USB port provides power for USB devices like mobile phones. You can connect your charging cable to the USB port and keep your phone topped up with juice while you watch television. Some users have even gotten a USB keyboard to work so that typing things into the search tool is faster. Overall it's not a huge boon, but it does provide some functionality for the lonely, forlorn USB port. The GenieGO DirecTV receiver allows you to download shows to your mobile devices to watch on the go. It also has a USB port that will support an external hard drive to add additional storage capacity. If you plug a USB hard drive into the USB port on the DirecTV, GenieGO will reformat the drive -- deleting everything on it -- and format it for use only with the DirecTV system. If you want to use the drive for anything else you will need to format it again, which means you'll lose those stored shows.
